Apprenticeship Level: Workboat crewmember (level 3)

Apprenticeship Framework: Level 3 Route: Transport and logistics Workboat Crewmember

Apprenticeship Duration: Approximately 2 years

Working Week: 40 hours at £4.30 per hour. Some evenings and weekends will be part of the training and job requirement

Basic qualifications required:

English, Maths, 'C' Grade or Level '4' preferable

Requirements:

Hard –working and eager to learn. With a positive can do attitude, flexible, self-motivated and showing Initiative

Willingness to work on the water , to take instruction and work as part of a team

Ability to get to work on time every day (limited public transport in the area)

Ability to obtain MCA ENG1 Medical or RYA ML5 Certificate

The marine apprentice will work alongside marine department staff who will mentor and train in various marine operations in the harbour. The apprenticeship will involve a mixture of 8–12 week maximum college attendance at Searegs Ltd, Plymouth , split over the two years, plus on the job training which will include completion of a several additional short courses as well as an end point assessment.
