CONSTRUCTION WORKS WITHIN PORTLAND INNER HARBOUR - UNAUTHORISED NAVIGATION PROHIBITED AREA

Mariners are advised that construction works will commence in the vicinity of Queens Pier on 29th April 2019.

This area is bounded by the following co-ordinates:-

50° 34.366N 002° 26.449W
50° 34.433N 002° 26.160W
50° 34.373N 002° 26.127W
50° 34.309N 002° 26.415W

Work barges and other marine craft will be operating within the immediate area until end of July 2019, also during this period an additional Mooring Dolphin will be constructed 60m beyond the existing Queens Pier Dolphin. Diving operations will be conducted at times.

All vessels involved in the construction works will display lights and shapes in accordance with the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collision) Regulations 1996 and a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 74.

The construction works are within the 'Unauthorised Navigation Prohibited Area' as marked on Admiralty Chart 2268.

All vessels are requested to pass at slow speed and remain clear of this area.

This Notice is issued under the powers vested by the Portland Harbour Revision Order 1997.
