THE 'TRAINING VESSEL TRISTRAM'

Notice is hereby given that military training will periodically take place on, above and below the Tristram. The Tristram is moored to the Southern end of the Outer Breakwater within Portland Inner Harbour approximate position 50°34'.32N 002°25.18W (Datum WGS84).

A 50-metre exclusion zone is established around the vessel.

Varied military exercises will take place to include, but not limited to, helicopter, diving, and boarding operations. At times RHIB's may make high speed runs towards the Tristram.

If there is any doubt as to the status of the military exercises taking place, clarification may be obtained by contacting Portland Harbour Radio on VHF Ch.74 or by telephoning 01305 825335.

In accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (as amended) the following signals will be displayed:

- 1) At all times the lights and shapes for a vessel at anchor:
 - i. In the fore part, an all-round white light or one ball
 - ii. At or near the stern and at a lower level than the light prescribed in subparagraph (i), an all-round white light
- 2) When diving is undertaken in the vicinity of TVT all dive vessels will prominently display International Code Flag 'A'
