### **DIVING AT WORK REGULATIONS 1997**

The Diving at Work Regulations 1997 require that commercial diving within a Harbour is undertaken safely and in accordance with the Regulations.

In order to assure itself that those obligations are met, Portland Harbour Authority only allow approved diving contractors to carry out commercial diving operations within Portland Harbour Authority Limits.

A list of approved diving contractors can be obtained from Portland Harbour Authority Limited.

Portland Harbour Authority requires all approved diving contractors, intending to carry out commercial diving operations within Portland Harbour Authority Limits, to obtain a permit to work from the Harbour Master prior to the commencement of operations.
