USE OF SOUND SIGNALS

Masters of all vessels whilst navigating within the Portland Harbour Authority area of jurisdiction are hereby reminded that a method in making their intentions clear to other vessels is to use the appropriate sound signals in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972, as amended.

Masters of all vessels are hereby reminded of the requirement to sound one prolonged blast on the ships whistle prior to passing through East or North Ship Channel to alert other small vessels.
