Local Notice to Mariners

No 14/2017

SPEED OF VESSELS

Mariners are hereby reminded of the speed of vessels within Portland Harbour as defined in The Portland Harbour Revision Order Schedule 1, part 2, paragraph 6.

The master of a power driven vessel greater than 10m LOA shall not cause or permit the vessel to proceed at a speed greater than 12 knots through the water when navigating:

- Within the Inner Harbour; and
- In the approaches thereto north of a line drawn 048⁰(T) from 'D Head'

The master of a power driven vessel shall not cause or permit the vessel to proceed at a speed greater than 6 knots through the water when navigating in the following areas:

- In Newton's Cove west of a line drawn 026⁰(T) from Torpedo Pier on the Northern Arm to the northern limit of the Harbour (120 metres east of the Nothe)
- Within 150 metres of the breakwaters, except as required to pass through the main fairways
- In the Inner Harbour
 - West of a line drawn 026⁰(T) from the New Channel Beacon to Torpedo Pier on the Northern Arm;
 - South of a line drawn 119⁰(T) from New Channel Beacon towards the North West corner of Queens Pier; and
 - South of a line drawn 251⁰(T) from Beacon E on the Outer Breakwater.

Unlit buoys will be placed to mark the six-knot limit on a seasonal basis only from the beginning of April to the end of October. The six-knot limit still applies when the buoys are not in place. The 6 knot limit is clearly marked on chart BA2268.
