By virtue of section 16 of the Portland Harbour Revision Order 1997 Portland Port Limited as the Harbour Authority gives the following Direction:

GENERAL DIRECTION

No. 2 of 2002

COMPULSORY TOWAGE IN PORTLAND HARBOUR

- 1. This Direction is given for the purpose of safety of navigation and the safety of persons and property in the harbour and shall apply at all times.
- 2. A Master of any vessel may request the assistance of a tug or tugs at any time.
- 3. For single screw vessels not fitted with manoeuvring aids the use of a tug, or tugs, is compulsory for the following movements:
 - (i) VESSELS ENTERING/LEAVING HARBOUR TO-FROM INNER HARBOUR ANCHORAGE

200 – 280 METERS LOA 2 TUGS 180 – 200 METERS LOA 1 TUG

(ii) VESSELS ENTERING/LEAVING HARBOUR TO/FROM ALONGSIDE BERTH

120 – 200 METERS LOA 2 TUGS 100 – 120 METRS LOA 1 TUG

- 4. Masters of vessels fitted with twin-screws and/or other manoeuvring aids are directed to use a tug or tugs as considered appropriate having considered the advice of the pilot.
- 5. Failure to comply with this Direction is an offence and offenders may be prosecuted.
