By virtue of section 16 of the Portland Harbour Revision Order 1997 Portland Harbour Authority Limited as the Harbour Authority gives the following Direction:



GENERAL DIRECTION

No 4 of 2007

AUTHORISED USE OF TIDAL WORKS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF PORTLAND HARBOUR (No 2)

- 1. This Direction is supplemental to Direction No 2 of 2004 made by the Harbour Authority on 4th August 2004.
- 2. The Harbour Authority has a statutory responsibility for regulating the use of Tidal Works within the limits of Portland Harbour. This authority is contained within the provisions of The Portland Harbour Revision Order 1997 and its various schedules.
- 3. No vessel or person shall at any time use any Tidal Work within the limits of Portland Harbour in such a manner as is likely to cause injury to persons or damage to property and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing no vessel shall navigate to or from a Tidal Work between sunset and sunrise unless the Harbour Master or a duly authorised member of his staff are present on duty within the limits of Portland Harbour.
- 4. Where attendance by the Harbour Master or a duly authorised member of his staff is required pursuant to article 3 of this Direction the Harbour Authority may make such charges as are reasonable for such attendance, pursuant to section 22 of the Portland Harbour Revision Order 1997
